# **2024 ANNUAL REPORT**

### Report from LSAA President Lynn Buckland-Brown:

This past year has been a whirlwind of activities for LSAA Members and those in the community who have attended LSAA events, exhibits, workshops, and *Art Talks*, which consist of artists sharing their knowledge and talent with LSAA members and the public.

We began our year in September with an *LSAA Annual Meeting and Potluck*. Door prizes, including a \$50 Blick gift certificate, won by Cindy Deo, were given out to attendees. Membership voted to accept the updated Bylaws and elected the Slate of Officers:

We also thanked outgoing President **Michele Tuccini**, retiring Board Member **Renee Michaud** and member **Diane Kordich** for their hours of dedicated service to keep LSAA active and aimed in the right direction so that it will remain a valuable asset to our community.

In October, painter John Hubbard presented a program on painting pets using acrylic paint.

Kim Danielson headed up the annual Membership Drive in January, which is different from previous years. LSAA changed the payment of membership dues to adhere to a fiscal year schedule, running from January 1<sup>st</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>, which was necessary due to tax filing requirements. Our programs, meetings, workshops, special events and exhibits are based on a calendar year, which begins September 1<sup>st</sup> and ends on August 31<sup>st</sup>.

**Lynn Buckland-Brown** presented an *Art Talk,* in January, and shared a documentary on the *Canadian Group of Seven.* **Judy Parlato** was inspired by what she learned and challenged her quilt group to create quilts based on the *Group of Seven's* paintings. Hopefully, they will be displayed at the Annual Meeting.

Our *Dog Daze of Winter* children's art exhibit and the *Winter Charm Exhibit* took place in in the Peter White Public Library in February. Fiber artist, **Judy Parlato** also shared her creations with fabric during the February *Art Talk*.

March brought an exciting new event! \*Celebrate the History of Art and Culture in Marquette was held in NMU's Peninsula Rooms, with Jack Deo and Ann Hilton Fisher presenting a wonderful slide show and talk about the founder of Art on the Rocks, Anita Meyland. As a first time event, we were pleased that 100 tickets sold. A successful silent auction and raffle took place, organized and run by Sandy and Chris Weber, and the proceeds were added to our yearly donation of \$1000.00 to the Lake Superior Art Association Scholarship Fund in honor of Anita Meyland. Thank you to the many LSAA members who contributed their time and talent to make this event successful and to everyone who donated items to the auction and raffle.

**Chris Burnett** shared his art of nature photography, in March, with an *Art Talk* titled, *Our Strange and Beautiful Land: Photography for Biodiversity*.

In April, LSAA members took a field trip to the \*NMU Art and Design Studios for a tour.

June was a busy month with a \*workshop by the Mokuhanga wood block printing artist **Mary Brodbeck**. The \*Fresh Coast Plein Air Painting Festival took place the last week on the month, coordinated by **Marlene Wood**, during MACC's Art Week.

**Tristan Louma** was, once again, the director of LSAA's annual outdoor art show, *Art on the Rocks*, which is always held on the last weekend of July. A group of LSAA board members, **Michele Tuccini**, **JoAnn Shelby** and **Marlene Wood**, also coordinated *Pebble Corner* for children, during this event.

Several board members have begun working on a new updated LSAA tri-fold, which will have current opportunities and information on our organization.

Much of the success of this year is due to the hard work of **June Jamrich-Parsons**, LSAA's Communications Director. June writes and sends out 5 issues of *The Kiosk*, LSAA's newsletter, keeps members updated on events and opportunities by sending out email messages, and publicizes events in newspapers and on television stations, when asked to do so.

None of these activities could have been possible without our members who step up and volunteer their time and talents to help plan and coordinate them. Kudos to our board, committees, and members who work countless hours promoting the arts in our community and keep LSAA rolling along!

#### **Grants Committee**

Prior to Covid, LSAA would give out grants, annually, to various individuals and groups in the community in need of financial assistance to participate in or provide materials for creating art. We decided that it was time to reinstate this program. Over the summer of 2024, several LSAA board members met, forming the Grants Committee, and created a *LSAA Visual Arts Grant Policy* and a *Grant Request Form*. During the August 2024 board meeting, both documents were approved. The program will be publicized this fall. The deadline for submission of the grant request form is January 1, 2025.

A new policy was also passed at the August board meeting stating that all grant requests made for the benefit and support of LSAA, Inc. must be presented to and approved by the LSAA Executive Board prior to application and a report given to the board if it was approved.

### **Archives Committee**

Thanks to LSAA member Diane Kordich and several volunteers, ten boxes of LSAA history was gone through and reduced to several. These were then brought to the Marquette Regional History Center to be stored and available to anyone who wishes to learn about our history. Minutes, agendas and other documents will be kept by the LSAA secretary for three years, then brought to the History Center to be added to our files.
