

The eighth annual Fresh Coast Plein Air Painting Festival and Competition, a Lake Superior Art Association annual summer event, will be held throughout Historic and Picturesque Marquette, Michigan and its magnificent shoreline on Friday & Saturday, June 27 -28. This year we have added a "Sales and Social Day" on Sunday, June 29, to give our community and visitors the opportunity to meet the artists, view their artwork, purchase paintings, and enjoy light refreshments and social relaxation. The festival is part of the "Grand Finale" of the City of Marquette Art Week. Art Week is a weeklong celebration of Marquette's creative community held during the last full week of June, featuring a wide range of community art projects, installations, performances, and more. Learn more about Art Week at https://www.mqtcompass.com/artweek/ This year's judging, reception, presentation of awards, artwork display and sale, and our new "Sales and Social Day" will be held at Marquette's comfortable and charming Presque Isle Pavilion, located on Lake Superior in Marquette's Presque Isle Park. Entered paintings are to be turned in at Presque Isle Pavilion, where they will be safely locked up and stored.

The 2025 Plein Air Festival combines our evening and daytime segments to allow artists to paint both times for one registration fee.

Friday, June 27, - "Dusk to Dark" Artists who participate in Dusk to Dark must register and have their canvases stamped that evening at The Presque Isle Pavilion. Once completed, artwork <u>must be turned in that evening</u> by **10:00 pm.** Emphasis should be placed on capturing the evening light, as it showcases sunset, nighttime cityscapes, etc.

Saturday, June 28 – "All-Day Painting" Artists participating in the daytime competition may get their canvases stamped on Friday evening or Saturday morning, then have until **4:30 pm** to submit their pieces for jurying, display, and sales at Presque Isle Pavilion. ***Artists may enter two paintings into the competition, painted either Friday evening or Saturday.

Painters must be 17 years old to enter the competition. Artists may paint anywhere within the Historic City of Marquette and along the Lake Superior Shoreline. All paintings must be stamped upon registration and created outdoors and on-site. businesses, or residents, giving artists a chance to share their visions of what they see and experience.

Entry levels (1) Professional and advanced painters,

(2) Novice, intermediate, emerging, and/or recreational painters.

Artists who have won a first-place award in the novice division are expected to enter the advanced artist level the following year.

Entry fees are payable online, by mail, and upon check-in at the event. Cash, checks, and online payments are all accepted – please make sure your registration is included.

Sunday, June 29 - "Sales and Social Day" - Open to Public

New this year is our "Sales and Social Day", taking place at Marquette's Presque Isle Pavillion from 9:30 -12:30. Artists may bring in **any** paintings they have painted throughout the weekend in Marquette, (including those not entered in the competition). Paintings must be priced to sell. We do not take any commission but would be thankful for any donations to help fund next year's event.

~\$4,000 in monetary and artist door prizes awarded.

1st, 2nd, and 3rd place for both competition levels, people's choice awards, and artist door prizes. Artists are encouraged to price their artwork if interested in selling during our public showing and reception.

Artwork will be judged this year by Pasqua Warstler from Escanaba, Michigan. A seasoned professional and award-winning artist, Pasqua has recently retired after many years as Gallery and Executive Director of the Bonifas Art Center in Escanaba. Her professional experiences include developing interdisciplinary curriculum, exhibits, public programming, and grants, providing learning opportunities to explore and learn through the arts. Her Gallery experience includes curating, installing, traveling exhibits, and judging competitions. Pasqua brings a deep understanding of the transformative power of the arts to her work. Constant observation and experimentation are the starting point of her creative process.
